The Interuniversity Library of the Sorbonne is hosting the exhibition **(IN)ERRANCE IV**, created by the artist-researchers of the **International Research Master in Arts & Vision (MAVI, School of Arts, Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne)**.

Through their works, these young artists explore the notions of wandering and displacement—not only as spatial experiences but also as creative processes. Their proposals unfold between anchoring and movement, certainty and uncertainty, revealing the poetic force of instability and ongoing research.

(IN)ERRANCE IV continues a collective reflection in which creation is envisioned as a journey, made of fragmented experiences, circulations, and resonances between bodies, territories, and imaginaries.
